This Technology Training program will provide an opportunity for students to obtain the knowledge and skills necessary to service microcomputer hardware and peripherals, build a computer from parts, install and maintain software, provide technical support to computer users, and prepare for a successful result on the CompTIA A+ 220-701 (Essentials) and A+ 220-702 (IT Technician) exams.

As a subcomponent of the course, students will also learn valuable job-readiness skills (i.e. resume writing, effective interviewing techniques, and job-search strategies) to pursue a career within the field of Information Technology.

The Technology Training program includes:

- 1) **Hands-on training with emphasis in computer networking**, this will provide you with the opportunity to troubleshoot and repair real equipment. Additionally, you will be able to understand network hardware, installation and support of basic computer networks.
- 2) Preparation for the **CompTIA A+ Certification**.
- 3) **Career Development Training** will help you prepare for a new career in Information Technology.
- 4) **Employment Services** will connect you with local employers and job opportunities in the industry.



We are providing FULL SCHOLARSHIPS to those candidates who qualify. The *Per Scholas* Scholarship will cover all registration fees, tuition costs, textbooks, supplies, and student support services. We are seeking candidates for our **January 10<sup>th</sup>, 2011** class. This will be a 15 week /450 hour training class ending on April 26<sup>th</sup>, 2011.
